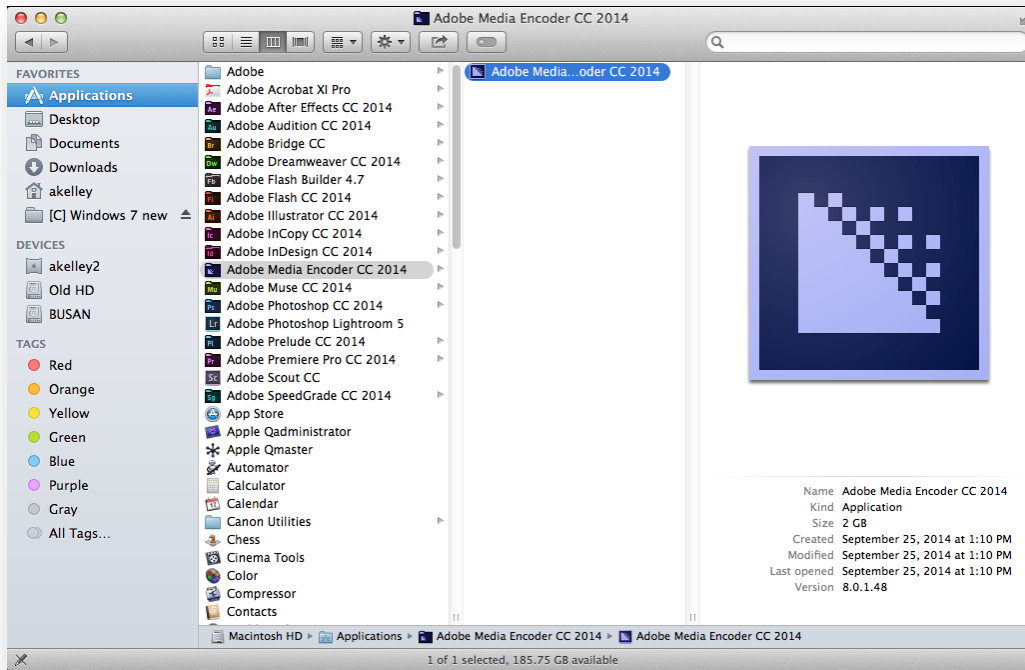
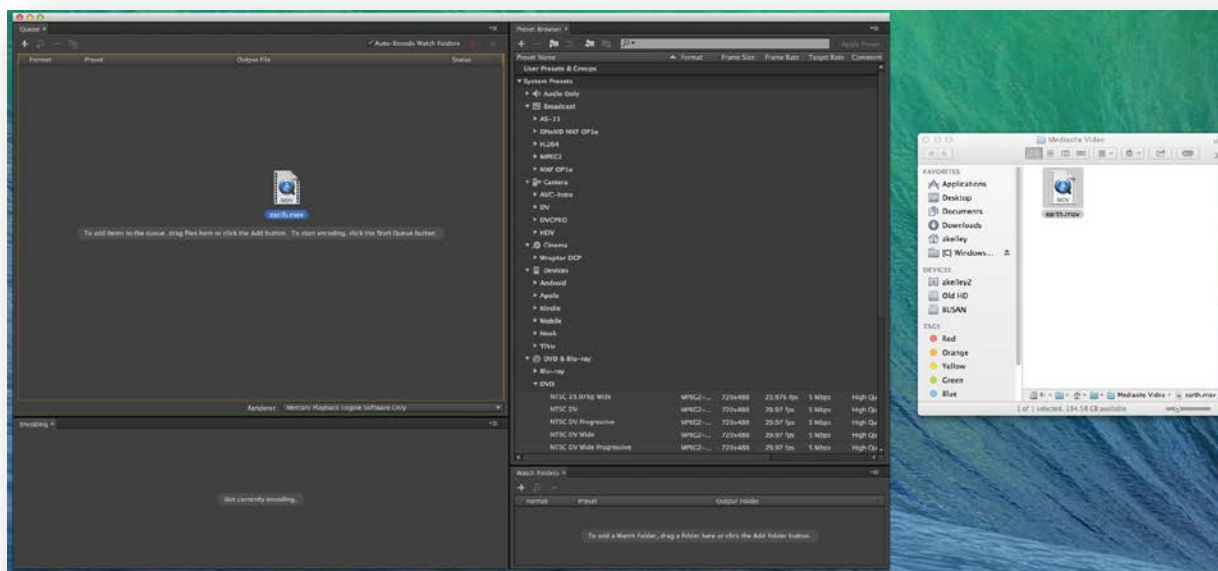


# Basic Video Compression for MyMediasite using Adobe Media Encoder CC 2014

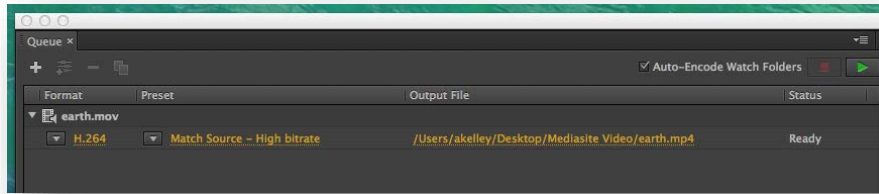
1. Launch "Adobe Media Encoder CC 2014".



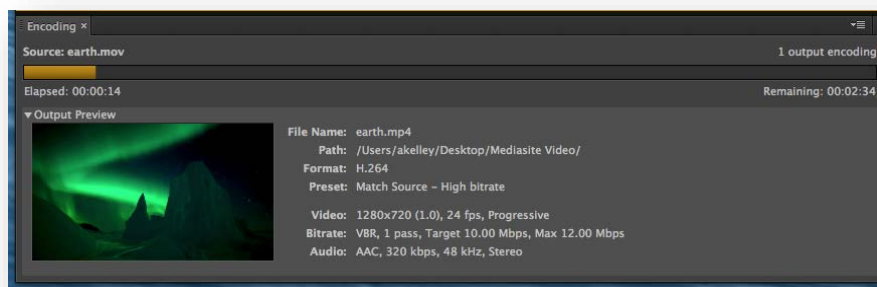
2. Drag your video file from finder into the top left pane of the Media Encoder interface.



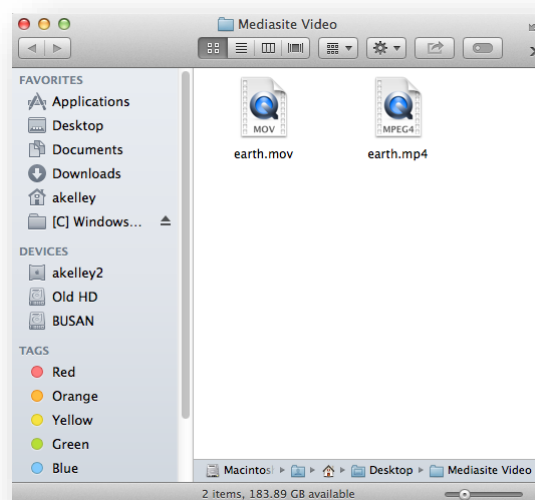
- The default “H.264”, “Match Source – High Bitrate” compression template should be applied automatically. The output “mp4” file will be saved to the same directory as the original file with the same name. Click the Green Play button in the top center of the interface to start the Queue.



- The bottom left pane of the interface will provide a progress bar and time remaining estimate. Wait for the compression to finish.



- When the encoding job disappears, you may quit “Adobe Media Encoder CC 2014”.
- The new file should be considerably smaller than the original and in a format easily acceptable by Mediasite.
