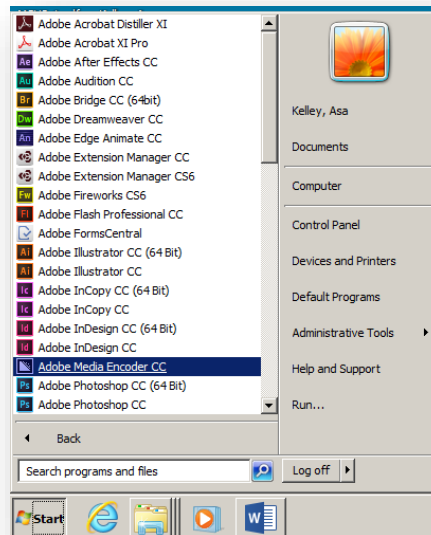
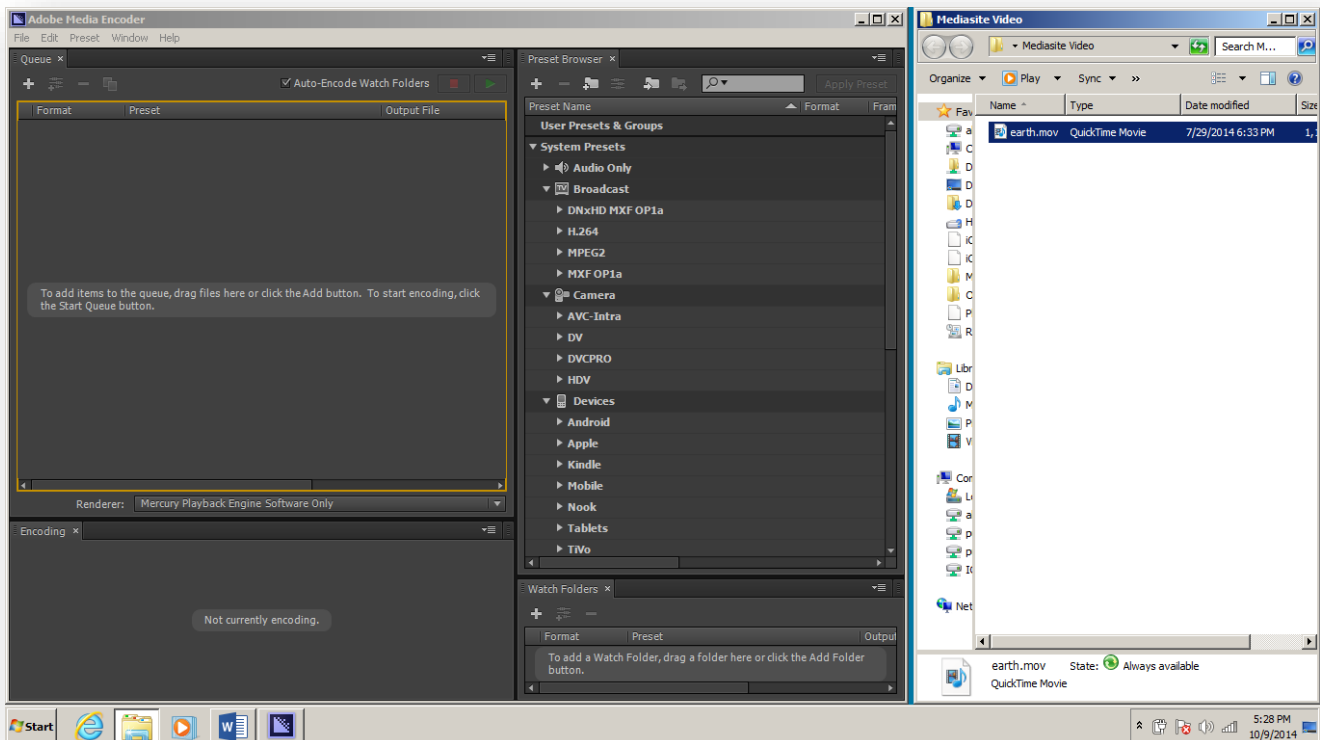


Basic Video Compression for MyMediasite using Adobe Media Encoder for Windows

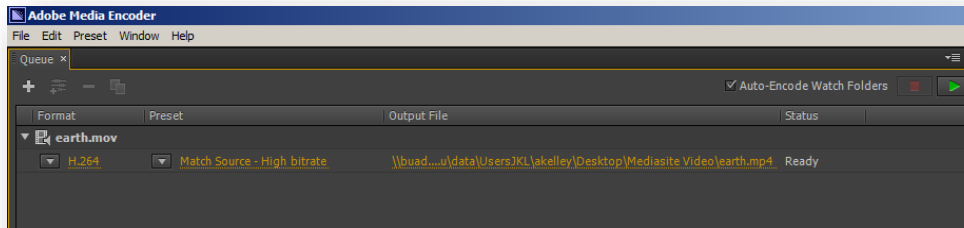
1. Launch "Adobe Media Encoder CC".



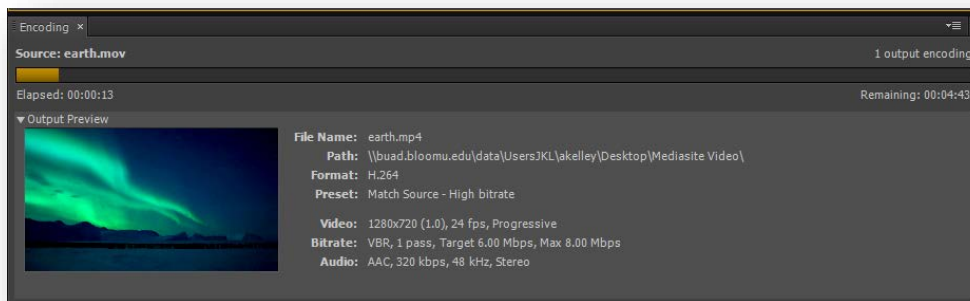
2. Drag your video file from Windows Explorer into the top left pane of the Media Encoder interface.



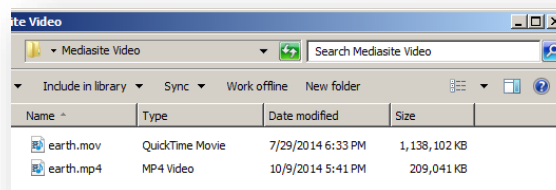
- The default “H.264”, “Match Source – High Bitrate” compression template should be applied automatically. The output “mp4” file will be saved to the same directory as the original file with the same name. Click the Green Play button in the top center of the interface to start the Queue.



- The bottom left pane of the interface will provide a progress bar and time remaining estimate. Wait for the compression to finish. It may take several minutes to finalize the file after the progress bar reaches the end.



- When the encoding job disappears, you may exit “Adobe Media Encoder CC”.
- The new file should be considerably smaller than the original and in a format easily acceptable by Mediasite.
